Special Note Regarding the 2021 AGM Nomination Voting Process

Greetings,

For our upcoming Annual General Meeting (AGM), members of Bethel Community Church will be asked to vote for our Church Council candidates, Lynn Thompson (Elder), Dan Lazazzera (Deacon) and Jim Hatley (Deacon). Those attending in-person at Bethel for the meeting (as permitted by the existing COVID rules at the time) will be given a paper ballot to complete.

Those attending the meeting online via Zoom will also be permitted one vote per candidate to be completed via email. Your attendance will be noted and an email will be sent to you with the names of the three candidates. We will ask you to reply to the email with your typed vote beside each name, either YES, NO, or ABSTAIN. Any couples watching online with shared email addresses will be asked to add your name to the bottom of the email so we can tally the responses correctly. We ask that your reply come within 12 hours of the close of the AGM, which means that we will not have the results to you until the following Sunday. For those unable to vote via email or who require assistance, please contact the office or myself before the AGM and we will receive your vote via telephone. This will be considered a proxy vote in accordance to our Bylaws.

I want to remind you that only active members of Bethel are allowed to vote in accordance with our Bylaws. If you have any questions regarding this process, please contact either myself or the office.
