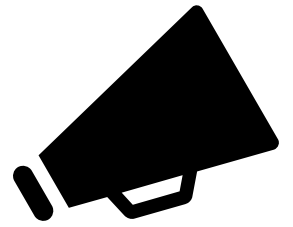

Watch for Premier Ford's announcement of the date the province will move into Phase 1 of the reopening plan because that's when...we'll begin hosting Sunday services **outside!**

Even though only 10 will be allowed in the building, we can have as many as we like outside, as long as households are at least 6 feet apart. And, those distanced and outdoors will may **unmasked** and **sing** (moderately). TV screens will be set up under the carport to share the live-stream from the worship centre. This will be offered **rain or shine**, so come prepared. In case of rain, some may prefer to watch it in their vehicle using a smart phone or tablet. The **wifi** range will be extended.

Bring your own **chair** (none will be provided). And if you like, pack a **lunch** and stay for a time of **fellowship** following the service.

For the safety of those seated in the parking lot, the St. Vincent St. entrance will be closed. All vehicles must use the **Penetang St.** (rear) entrance.

Going forward, even when we're able to have more people in the building, we will **still offer** outdoor live-stream viewing for those who want to sing or be unmasked.
