We moved into a revised Phase 1 reopening plan as of Friday June 11, with **15% capacity** allowed in the building! Also, many may attend **outside**, as long as households are distanced.

Those outdoors will be able to participate **unmasked** and will be free to **sing**. A TV will be set up under the carport to share the live-stream from the worship centre. Some may like to go out to sing during the music segment and then **come in** for the sermon. It's up to you.

Bring your own **chair** since none will be provided. And, if you like, pack a **lunch** and stay for a time of **fellowship** following the service.

As long as there's demand for it, the outdoor option will be offered, **rain or shine**. Please note a correction from last week: the **wifi** range hasn't been extended after all, so watching on a device in your car won't work. But, you'll be able to come into the worship centre (masked) if the weather is bad.
