An Important Message From Your Council

Bethel, and many Bethelites, have loved the ministry of Camp Promise and have been strong supporters throughout the years. So, it is with the greatest sadness that Bethel's Leadership Council recently came to the conclusion that we could no longer host the ministry of Camp Promise at Bethel after June of this year. This follows years of prayerful consideration by Bethel's Board. After a recent meeting, Bethel's Council openly discussed the matter at length and agreed that the working relationship between Camp Promise and Bethel has always differed from what we had envisioned and documented it to be in the beginning. Because of the confidential nature of the issues involved, we will not be releasing further details of this discussion nor expanding on our reasons for this decision.

Camp Promise is now firmly established as a separate charitable entity with its own leadership board, and we bless its future ministry endeavours.
